Dr. James Kyle, board member for the California Endowment, is the recipient of the Humanitarian Award at this year's awards luncheon, "Celebrating Life's Precious Jewels."

Early on in his career, he worked as an ordained minister and has retained a strong commitment to the community and social change through his work as a trustee for Catholic Healthcare West, and Shields for Families, a nonprofit, community-based organization in Watts dedicated to

developing, delivering and evaluating culturally sensitive, comprehensive service models that empower and advocate for families affected by substance abuse and child abuse.
