



Ramos Family Honors Ted Alejandre

San Manuel's Ramos Family will honor Ted Alejandre with its prestigious "Ramos Family Spirit of Compassion Award" at the Time for Change Foundation's (TFCF) 15th Year Anniversary and Awards Gala.

San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools' Ted Alejandre began his fouryear term as the county's 34th superintendent on Jan. 5 after being elected to office in June 2014. With more than 28 years of experience in public education, Mr. Alejandre has been a teacher, vice principal, principal and director of fiscal services at the district level, and served as the assistant superintendent of Business Services in the Yucaipa-Calimesa Joint Unified School District.

He joined County Schools in 2008 as the assistant superintendent of Business Services, and later was appointed deputy superintendent, overseeing all operations of the organization. As county superintendent, Mr. Alejandre works collaboratively with educators, families, other agencies and stakeholders to

provide advocacy, leadership and services for and on behalf of the 411,000 K-12 students attending public schools in San Bernardino County. His office oversees a \$230 million annual operating budget and employs nearly 2,000 employees.

"We are honoring Mr. Alejandre because he represents our compassionate concern for others, while demonstrating leadership that embraces the whole community and good will for all," says Alaina Ramos-Mathews.
